The Design Your MK Gallery Brief

Open to school pupils of all ages, we invite you to use your imagination and design your perfect gallery. You never know, your design might become part of the future MK Gallery building!

1. Your design can be 2D or 3D, and use any materials that you think best represent your vision for the Gallery. For example, you might want to use an old shoebox as the basic shape of the building. (We ask that no work has a footprint bigger than A3 sized paper).
2. We hope that our expansion will include a cinema, a café and a bigger bookshop – but what do you think a gallery should include? You can be as imaginative as you like.
3. We would like to include as many designs in our exhibition as possible. To ensure your design gets chosen please make sure everything is stuck down securely, and the design is completely finished before you submit it.
4. When you are completely happy with your design, drop it off at MK Gallery, 900 Midsummer Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes, MK9 9QA by the **deadline: 24 November 2013**
5. Please ensure that you include your name, age and school on the back of your design.




