This exhibition shows the art work of 130 artists in five gallery spaces. The art works include sculpture, drawing, painting, photography, printmaking and textiles.



All the art work which is loud, flashing or fast moving will be switched off so that the space is calm and quiet for me to enjoy.

The relaxed exhibition opening starts at 10 o'clock and finishes at 12 o'clock.



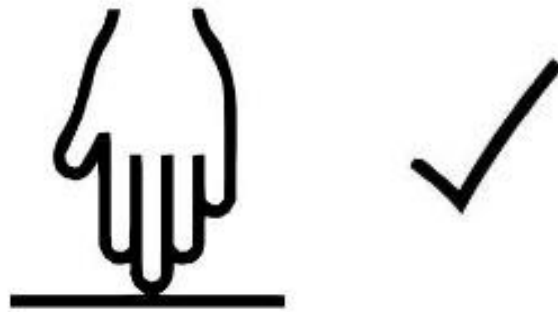
When I enter the gallery spaces I can borrow ear defenders or sensory aids from the welcome table or I can take my own in.



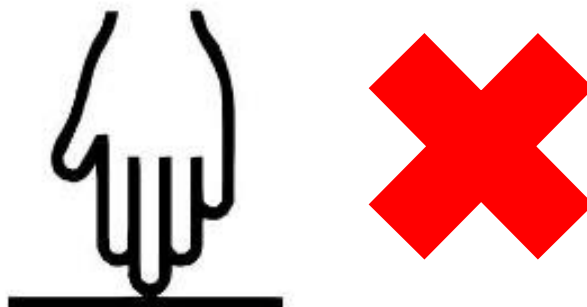
Most art work can't be touched.



I will know if I can touch something as I will see a sign next to it that looks like this:



This different sign will remind me not to touch things which are extra fragile to help keep me safe:



If I need the toilet I will leave the gallery. Staff will tell me where the nearest toilets are or I can follow the WC signs. I can use the stairs or a lift. The Changing Places Toilet is on the ground floor.

The hand driers will all be turned off so they won't be noisy.



When the relaxed opening finishes at 12 o'clock all the art work will be switched back on. It will get a bit louder and busier but I can stay for as long as I like.
